Why is Membership important?

Church membership is important for several reasons:

1. We believe membership is Biblical. While the term 'church member' isn't used in the Bible, the imagery and concept of 'membership' (or belonging to a specific local church fellowship) is implicit throughout the New Testament.

While every Christian is a *POSITIONAL* member of God's church (1 Cor. 12:12-13), the Bible also urges positional members to grow in their faith in the context of a local church body – or to become *PARTICIPATING MEMBERS* (Rom. 12:4-8; Eph. 2:19-21). To be a Christian and not belong to a specific local church fellowship is like a football player saying "I want to play football but don't want to play on a specific team". There are over thirty instructions in the New Testament that you cannot obey unless you are a part of a local church family (ie: Heb. 10:24).

2. Membership is valuable in that it identifies those who truly comprise the flock of our church – those who are in agreement with the doctrines and direction of our church, are people of integrity and moral purity and can be counted on to build and sustain the ministries of the church. This also helps the leaders of the church as they seek to fulfill their God-given task of caring for the flock.

What am I committing to if I become a member?

You are committing to grow in your walk with Christ and be part of the community of RockPointe Church. In addition, you are saying that you agree with the vision, values and direction the church is taking and that you will use your gifts in ministry and money to help accomplish the vision.

Specifically, you are committing to the following statements:

- To protect the unity of my church
- To share in the responsibility of my church
- To use my gifts to serve the ministry of my church
- To generously donate money to advance the ministry of my church
- To support the testimony of my church
- To become a committed member of one of our small groups

How do I become a member?

The process for membership is a simple one. The following steps are requested in order to be received into membership.

- Make a profession of faith in Jesus Christ and be baptized.
- Be a 'regular attendee' for at least 3 months and begin to use your gifts to serve in the church.
- Attend a Membership Class.
- Complete the Membership Application packet.
- Be interviewed by a member(s) of the Elders Board through whom your application receives approval.
- Be received into membership at a regular Elders Meeting.
