- praise for some new believers at church. One lady named Ning came to the Lord this week. Her husband is my friend and he has been working on her for a while. He wants to plant a church one day as well and so this was always a tough thing for him that his wife wasn't a believer.
- also a guy named Big. He has been coming since our Christmas outreach and came forward for prayer after my sermon on Sunday. He once was involved in a church but faded away.
- I got my visa for India. This can't be publicly said on camera or anything. I will be going from Feb 2-18. Bible school students for the first half, then training 15 pastors for the second half. there are 55+ students waiting for us and a large group of pastors who will be coming from around the country. I will then help lead our church camp on the 20-22 here in Chiang Rai.
- I also just found out that one of the main leaders there (India) is being pressured to leave the ministry to go and work because his dad needs an eye surgery for around \$1000-\$1200 cdn. So I am praying about how we can respond.
- pray for Jayda's friend Minnie. She came to the Lord recently and none of her family is Christian. Her and Jayda go to another church on Sunday mornings and seem to be doing well, but it's tough in Thailand to not go to family events at temples. Alexa is her youth pastor at school and has mentored her as well.
- prayers for our family as we look at possibly going back to Canada for a very quick family trip at Easter. It may be the last time for Jayda before university. This summer we plan to try to go visit her university choice in Lithuania if possible. (Cody wants to explore a university in Tokyo) Both kids are really chill about it all, but we want to try our best to be able to go see the schools face to face before committing to anything.

Even though the scarf was expensive, it didn’t really need to be marked “up” to become in the senders mind as more valuable and therefore maybe treated with more care in shipping.”

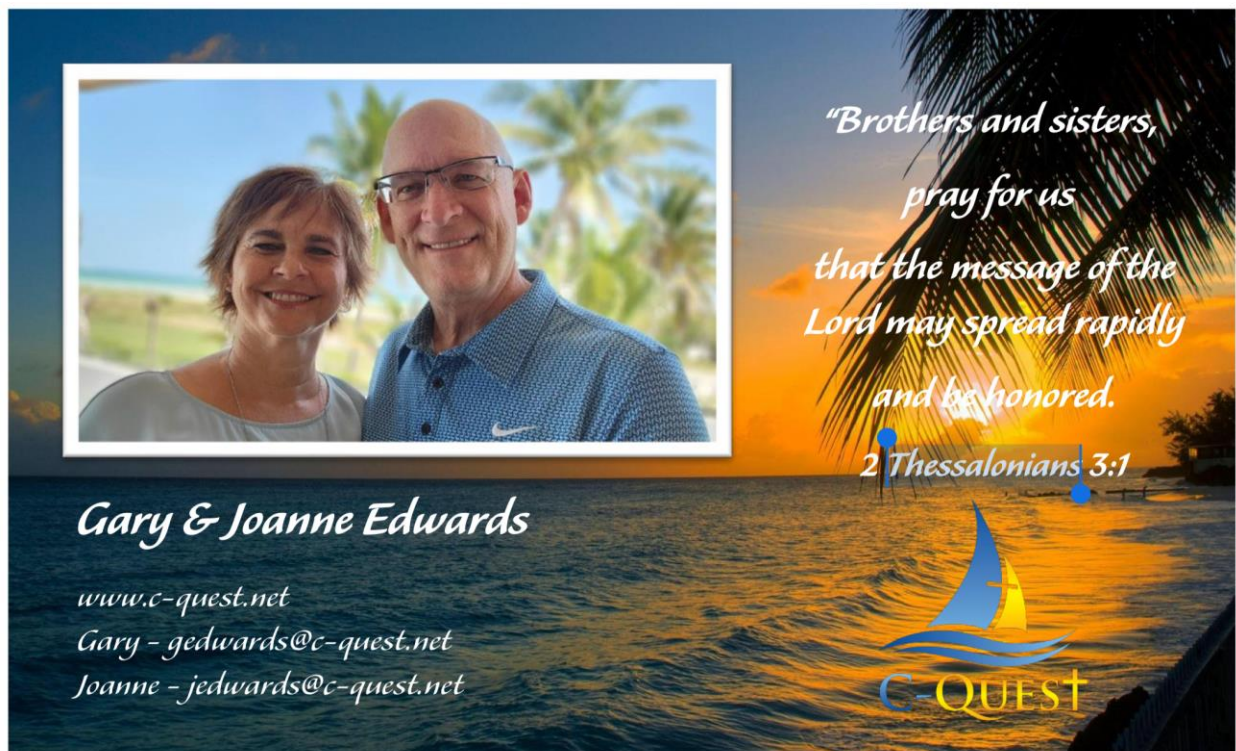
Prayer Requests

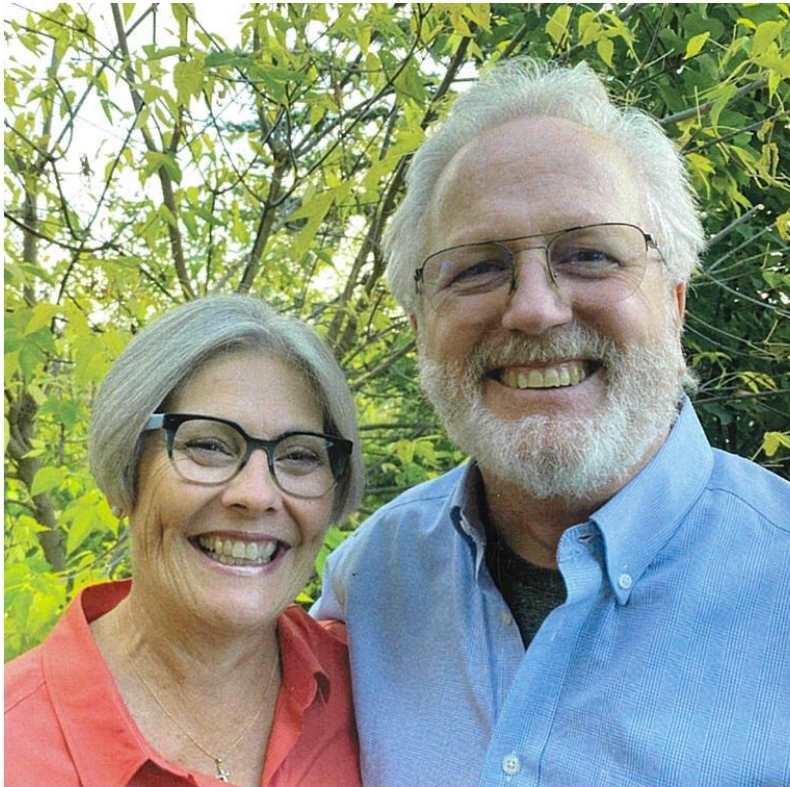

Matthew 25:14-30

If you were put on the spot and asked to state the point of this parable, what would you say?

Mt 25:14 says, “Again, it will be like a man going on a journey.....”

What will be like a man going on a journey? (Hint: Mt 25:1).

What do you think the various elements of this parable represent?

- The Master: (Jesus)
- The Journey: (The time between his ascension and his second coming)
- The servants: (You’ve got this.....)
- The *talents: (Resources of any kind that God has given you)

Why do you think the Master would give varying amounts to his servants?

To whom do the talents and their growth ultimately belong?

As a servant, how would you react if you were given more or less than your peers?

What are the expectations placed on a servant who is stewarding their Master’s talents?

What talents have been entrusted to you?

In light of the mission that Christ has given us, what would the expected use of the talents entrusted to you be?

What do you think it means to ‘enter into the joy of your Master?’

How did the Master react to the two servants who did well?

What kind of person does the lazy servant represent?

What do you feel God is asking you to do with the talents he has given you?

What steps will you take to move forward in the stewardship of your talents?

How will you use the talents entrusted to you to aid in the advancement of God’s Kingdom?

*A talent is 33kg. If it were gold, at today’s prices the value would be over \$8m. The point is not the value of the treasure, it is the extravagant nature of the Master.
