New Ventures Fund: \$4,500 behind

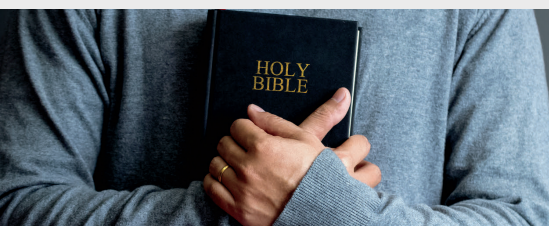
