Dress Code

Everything we do on the Church platform is meant to bring glory to God and be sensitive to cultural differences. This means that we must ensure that we present ourselves in a manner that respects cultural backgrounds and sensitivities. All volunteers should dress modestly.

- No overly tight clothing. Women: no short skirts or short dresses.
- No sleeveless or revealing tops.
- No cycling shorts (skin tight)
- Ladies, Pants and Shorts: shorts (knee-length). No leggings or pants that are tight all the way to the ankle unless you wear a long top that goes mid-thigh.
- Symbols and Logos: Clothing must not contain words or symbols of profanity, crude imagery, alcohol or drug references, or other inappropriate things. Please do not wear political or otherwise divisive clothing.
- Tattoos: Clothing should cover all offensive tattoos.
