THE ROLE

RockPointe Community Service Worker

These positions will assist RockPointe ministry teams with programming, both in our buildings and out in our communities throughout the summer. This team will be expected to take initiative to better support RockPointe families and our relationships with community partners, as well as seek out new relationships with others that are helping communities in need. Throughout the summer they will plan, organize, implement and lead various events, ministries and programs to benefit our community and families.

More than just accomplishing tasks, the Community Service Worker will also be developed in leadership skills and learn to take ownership over their personal growth. Ultimately, this opportunity will develop them as a leader and contributor in a church community to serve others through their work.

ROLE SPECIFICS

All 9 roles will share similarities, but some will have specific ministry focus:

- 3 open positions - Children's Ministry focus
- 4 open positions - RockPointe Intercultural focus
- 1 open position - Young Adults Ministry focus
- 1 open position - Youth Ministry focus

These Community Service Workers will help implement summer programs both in the community, and onsite, with a focus on the specific ministry they support.

DETAILS

- All positions have been approved for a 8 week term: July 2 – August 26

- All positions will be **35 hrs/week** (days and hours will change depending on projects and needs)
- All positions will work out of a RockPointe Site (Bowridge/Bearspaw)
- All positions will report to the Pastor of Ministry Support
